

National Student Outcomes Survey 2022 —questionnaire

Introduction

The 2022 domestic student questionnaire suite was designed to ensure students received only questions relevant to them. The questionnaires included:

- pulse questionnaire for continuing students (approximately 5 minutes)
- full questionnaire for Certificate II and above qualification completers (approximately 10 minutes)
- lite questionnaire for all other students (approximately 5 to 10 minutes)

This document combines these three domestic student questionnaires into one questionnaire.
