## Progress of the new VET Information Standard

In line with their commitment to the National Skills Agreement, the Commonwealth and state and territory governments have approved the new VET Information Standard which will replace the AVETMISS 8.0 VET Provider Collection. This new standard is a cornerstone of the VET Data Streamlining (VDS) initiative and will be progressively implemented, with the sector fully transitioned by 31 December 2028.

### What does this mean for training providers and SMS vendors?

No action is required at this stage.
